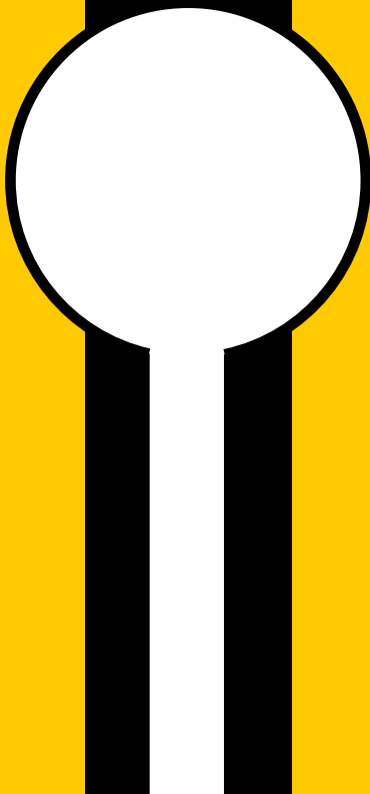

STEP BY STEP RETURN TO SERVICE

Repairer or Inspector Tasks

Before releasing the vehicle to the customer:

- Fill out the repairer/inspector & vehicle details on the **RTS** tag.
- Inspect the customer tank or tanker.
- Complete the **RTS** checklist.
- Sign the **RTS** tag.
- Attach the **RTS** tag to truck steering wheel, if no truck is available attach tag to the tanker driveaway protection gate.

Driver or Loader Tasks

Before loading the tanker for the first time.

- Inspect the tank or tanker.
- Complete the 8 driver **RTS** tag checks.
- Initial each item on the **RTS** tag as you check the tank or tanker.
- Enter your full name.
- Sign the **RTS** tag.
- Present the **RTS** tag to fuel terminal staff at the first fuel terminal you attend for loading.

Terminal Supervisor Tasks

- Accept the Return to Service tag from the driver.
- Consider inspecting the tanker before authorising the load.
